

Graduation Requirements for International Students in BC

General Requirements (80 credits – at least 16 credits must be Grade 12)

In order to graduate, students must pass specific courses. Overall, each student must acquire 80 credits from a combination of required courses, elective courses, Career Life Connections 12 and the Provincial Assessments

Required Courses (48 credits)

A. The following courses must be completed by a Certified BC Teacher

- Career Life Education 10 (4 credits)
- a Language Arts 11 (4 credits)
- a Language Arts 12 (4 credits)
- a Mathematics 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- a Science 11 or 12 (4 credits)
- a Social Studies 11 or 12 (Law 12 , Geography 12, History 12, BCFN 12) (4 credits)

B. The following courses are required courses that can be completed in other countries or provinces. *Credit can be gained through equivalency process

Elective Courses (28 credits)

Credits from elective courses will be counted from Grades 10 to 12. When planning course selection, remember that at least 16 overall credits must be at the Grade 12 level.
