This letter confirms that **Wynter Oakes** was a full-time student in Central Okanagan Public Schools in Grade 11 at George Elliot Secondary School in Kelowna, British Columbia, Canada from 9/1/2024 until 6/30/2025 of the 2024-2025 school year.

As per the BC Ministry of Education and Child Care, the Central Okanagan Public School District runs secondary schools on a semester-based system with a two-semester model. The first semester runs from September to January and the second from February to June. During the academic school year, secondary students are enrolled in a minimum of 8 courses which are evenly distributed between the two academic semesters. This system is widely used in schools across British Columbia and Canada and is approved by the Ministry of Education and Child Care.

In the British Columbia education system, secondary students have 80 minutes of instruction in each of their classes each day. Furthermore, each year-long course has 120 hours of instruction and receives 4 credits (1 credit = 30 hours). However, in a semester system, students are given twice the hourly instruction per subject per week allowing them to complete the required 120 hours per course during a semester in an accelerated manner. As such, the credits earned for a course still represent the work of an entire year-long course (10 months), even though the learning outcomes are achieved in half the time (5 months). In addition to hours of instruction, for a student to receive full credit for a course, they must also meet the required learning outcomes for the course as identified in the BC Ministry of Education and Child Care curriculum.
