Global Intercultural Experience Course

The Global Intercultural Experience course is part of the Global & Intercultural Skills Program. However, the out-of-timetable GIE course is also available for any SD23 student to take as a single elective course for graduation requirements.

SD23 International Education Host Siblings

GIE Host Sibling Stream

By being part of a host family, students in grades 10, 11, or 12 fulfill two of the three experiences required by the Global Intercultural Experience course. A third experience, relating to Indigenous culture, is planned and organized by the district which students can sign up to participate in the activity.

GIE Course Outline

The **Global Intercultural Experience** course for host sibling students involves completing:

- Weekly reflection tasks as well as check-ins with the GIE teacher.
- An Experience Portfolio for three intercultural experiences, one of which must relate to Indigenous culture.
- A Final Presentation of Learning.
